Firewise Mitigation Work Completed for 2025

Please use this form to record work that you have completed on your property to mitigate wildfire risk. This can be hours worked on your or your neighbor's property or a total of monies spent to rent or purchase equipment, or monies spent to hire someone to do the mitigation for you.

The Burland HOA will use the summary information to maintain our neighborhood Firewise Status. This status helps show that we have a reduced risk from wildfires and that can help with insurance rates and even insurability.

Here are some examples of mitigation tasks that count towards retaining our Firewise status. These can include raking pine needles, leaves and debris, trimming trees and bushes, removing trees, mowing your grass, cleaning out your gutters and downspouts. Removing tree due to beetle kill also counts!
